

BOYS GOLF RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Must attend all classes each day to participate.
Exceptions: Dr.'s note, Dentists note, Court note.
A parent note will not do.
2. Must keep G.P.A. above 2.0 and be passing all classes.
See Athletic Handbook for repercussions.
3. Must be at practices or matches every scheduled day.
Exceptions: Religious observance, schoolwork priority, family emergency.
THESE EXCEPTIONS MUST BE COMMUNICATED TO COACH KINSLEY IN ADVANCE WHEN POSSIBLE.
4. School disciplinary issues may result in Golf Team consequences.
 - A. After school detentions: No participation for that day
 - B. Suspension from school: No participation during the suspension and for 1 match following the return to school.
5. Golf Course disciplinary issues will result in Golf Team consequences.
 - A. Abusive language, swearing, cell phone usage and club throwing.
Practice: 1st offense – Warning
2nd offense – Suspension from next match
3rd offense – Removal from Team.

Match: 1st offense – 2 stroke penalty and 1 match suspension.
2nd offense – Same match – Disqualified and 1 match suspension.
Different match – 2 stroke penalty and 2 match suspension.
3rd offense – Removal from team.
 - B. Use of tobacco, alcohol, drugs or wagering will result in being removed from the team.
 - C. Malicious Damage: Any player intentionally damaging equipment or the golf course.
Practice: 1st offense – 1 match suspension.
2nd offense – Removal from Team.

Match: 1st offense: - Disqualified from match and 1 match suspension.
2nd offense: - Disqualified from match and removal from Team.
6. Dress Code will violations result in Non-participation. While Maplewood is fairly lax on a dress code, the Kingco Conference is not. The following items must be worn in a match.
 - A. Shoes
 - B. Slacks or cords or walking shorts (except at Overlake)

C. Shirt with a collar

Optional: 1. Sweater over a collared shirt

2. Rain Gear

3. Hat with bill facing forward

7. Spectators will be allowed on the course for matches only when allowed by the course, provided that they: (not allowed at Maplewood)
- A. Stay at least 25 yards behind the players.
 - B. Are not in close contact with the players.
 - C. Do not give advice or instruction during the match.
 - 1st offense: Verbal warning (given on the 1st tee box).
 - 2nd offense: Player receives a 2 stroke penalty and a 1 match suspension.
 - 3rd offense: Player disqualified from match and a 1 match suspension. Spectator will be asked not to attend future matches.
8. Transportation Field Trip Forms must be on file and adhered to.
9. Matches will consist of 10 players with all 10 designated as varsity. The top 5 Scores count in the team totals.
10. Any player playing as a Varsity player whose score is used in 2 matches (top 5) will letter as long as the player finishes the year in good standing.
